

- NO - Tank tops, strapless tops, backless tops, tops that expose the midriff and tops that are low cut.
- NO- Shorts (on men or women).
- NO – Pajamas
- NO- Jeans with any rips, tears or frays. No sagging of any kind allowed.
- NO- T-shirts (on men or women).
- NO- Clothing that displays inappropriate writing or pictures (including references to violence, alcohol, drugs or sexual matter).
- NO- Slippers, bare feet, rubber shoes or flip-flops (dress sandals are allowed).
- NO- Leggings when worn as pants (allowed if worn as tights under skirts/dresses).
- NO- Dresses or skirts shorter than the fingertips of extended arms.
- NO- Formed fitting dresses, shirts or one-piece bodysuits.
- NO- Hats, bandanas, bonnets or du-rags.
